ZERO TOLERANCE FOR SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

The city of Las Vegas Department of Public Safety maintains “**zero tolerance**” regarding any and all forms of sexual misconduct between any staff, contractor, or volunteer and inmate or solely between inmates. Any staff member, contractor, or volunteer who engages in, fails to report, or knowingly condones sexual abuse, sexual harassment, or sexual misconduct shall be subject to disciplinary actions up to and including termination and may be criminally prosecuted. The department and the facility preserve a proactive approach in the prevention, detection, response to, and punishment of any PREA related violations.

All inmates have the right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment at this facility. Any abusive sexual contact between inmates, or inmates and staff, volunteers, and contractors is against the law. If you wish to report an alleged incident of sexual abuse or sexual harassment on behalf of an inmate, you may do so in any of the ways below:
