Stewart Avenue Complete Streets Project

IMPROVING SAFETY, EQUITY, AND ACCESS FROM 6TH STREET TO NELLIS BOULEVARD

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The City of Las Vegas was awarded a \$23.9 million federal grant to reconstruct Stewart Avenue and develop a more safe, comfortable, and attractive corridor for our community. Through the grant, we will deliver a corridor that provides wider sidewalks, a two-way bikeway separated from moving vehicles, lower speed limits, community banners and lighting, addition of landscaping and street trees, bus stop improvements, and intersection technology enhancements.

Because we are using federal funds, we must adhere to the National

Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) that requires completing an environmental study to identify and evaluate potential social and environmental effects of a project. During this process, we will seek your input about how to best meet the needs of the community. Your participation is critical to designing and building a successful corridor.

This project will also include Clark County Regional Flood Control District storm drain facilities along Stewart Avenue from Eastern Avenue to the Las Vegas Wash.

PROPOSED STEWART AVENUE STREET CONFIGURATIONS

The Stewart Avenue Complete Streets Project, 6th Street to Nellis Boulevard, will upgrade this corridor to provide safe, accessible, and comfortable transportation choices for all corridor users and modes, including walking, bicycling, and driving. The following graphics illustrate the three primary street configurations that will be constructed along the 4.3-mile corridor, accounting for differences in street widths, adjacent land uses, and bikeway design.

Segment 1: 6th Street to Bruce Street



Segment 2: Bruce Street to Eastern Avenue



Segment 3: Eastern Avenue to Nellis Boulevard
